We are happy to introduce some new partners, [Breast Treatment Task Force](#) and the [Project Renewal Scan Van](#). Together, these organizations assist uninsured women in accessing mammograms and/or clinical breast exams, as well as further tests if needed. This program is free for uninsured patients.

Under the age of 40

Patients under 40 will be provided with free exams that are appropriate for their circumstance. Often, the best option for a patient under 40 is to begin with a clinical breast exam. If you need further testing, a mammogram and/or diagnostic tests will also be arranged.

40 and older

Their program welcomes patients 40 and older who have not had a mammogram in the past year.

Patients that have abnormal findings are contacted by a navigator within 5 business days. The navigator will discuss the results with the patient and arrange follow-up appointments for diagnostic procedures that will be paid for by the BTTF program if needed.
