## THE PROBLEM



67,000 working uninsured women cannot access breast care.



Most breast care programs are restricted to women ages 50+.



Most breast care programs focus on advocacy or research, and do not pay for direct services (e.g., diagnostics) like BTTF.

## WHO WE SERVE



### AVERAGE INCOME

Earns \$30,000 per year.

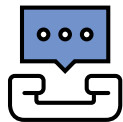
### HEALTH AWARENESS

Proactive interest in health; attends appointments.

### INSURANCE STATUS

Earns too much to enroll in Medicaid, but can't afford health insurance at \$300+ per month.

## THE SOLUTION: BTTF MODEL



BTTF's network of community organizations efficiently refers uninsured patients into the program.



BTTF pays reduced rates for services (otherwise unused capacity) to private imaging centers.

Our continued mission is to provide services to low-income uninsured patients above Medicaid eligibility.
